

Lt. Governor: Endorsing Mead Treadwell

Candidates: Mead Treadwell, Eddie Burke, Jay Ramras

The vetting committee has completed a thorough investigation into all candidates for the position of Lieutenant Governor. CPG has had to make a decision between two conservative candidates for Lieutenant Governor, Mead Treadwell and Eddie Burke. Both of these candidates received an 8.5-9.0 rating. CPG has endorsed the conservative candidate we believe has the best prospect of winning in the general election.

Mead Treadwell – Rating 8.5-9.0

During the vetting committee's investigation of Mr. Treadwell issues arose regarding his position on global warming. Mr. Treadwell was verbally questioned regarding his position on this issue and was asked to submit a written position statement. His written statement reads as follows:

I challenge the argument that man made CO2 emissions are causing significant global warming and I will oppose any costly new regulations that would increase unemployment, raise consumer prices and weaken the nation's global competitiveness.

1. Skepticism is the cornerstone of science. The climate science gaps are way too large – in observation, in modeling, in planetary physics – to support coercive governmental decisions, like the endangered species act determinations affecting Alaska.

2. I absolutely oppose carbon taxes, cap and trade, or other coercive social engineering.

3. I support innovation and investment in new energy technologies as it helps our national security, and helps Alaska base its economy on long-term, low cost energy.

Mr. Treadwell's verbal representation and this written response allayed the vetting committee's concerns on this matter and given their conclusion that he is the more electable of the two conservative candidates in the general election he was endorsed by CPG.

Eddie Burke – Rating 8.5-9.0

Eddy Burke is a conservative. However, when we have two conservative candidates competing for a position CPG must look at other factors such as their electability in the general election. Mr. Burke has made uncomplimentary remarks on his radio talk show about individuals on several different occasions. CPG believes these remarks will be used by his Democrat opponent and the liberal news media in an attempt to discredit Mr. Burke should he win the primary. Mr. Burke has provided us in the past, we must endorse the conservative candidate we believe has the best prospect of winning in the general election.

Jay Ramras – Rating 6.5




